

Day Wise Itinerary

Day 1



Airport - Kandy

- Welcome to Sri Lanka! Our representative will meet you at the Bandaranaike International Airport and then you'll be escorted to your vehicle to begin your adventure in Sri Lanka. Drive to Kandy.
- On arrival check-in to the hotel and relax.
- In the afternoon proceed for a **city tour in Kandy**. Visit the Upper & Lower Lake Drives, Kandy Museum, Tea Museum, Arts & Crafts center, famous Kandy Market amongst the other very interesting sights.
- On completion return back to the hotel.
- Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 2



Hantana Hiking

- Morning after breakfast at 7.00 am proceed to the starting point. You will be given instructions and what rules to be followed.
- After a quick session of warm-up start the hike. Then proceed in the trail where the route is marked.
- Take care of your own safety. Be sure not to destroy anything but enjoy the wonderful scenic view.
- Stop for lunch and relaxation. Enjoy the cool climate.
- On completion continue your journey and then decent through the forest.
- Once you have finished your hike you will participate in a warm down session.
- Then you will be accompanied to a reserved place for a launch of conservation project of planting trees. Each of you will be given a tree to plant.
- On completion return back to the hotel and relax.
- In the evening participate in a post event cocktail which will followed by dinner.
- Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 3



Kandy – Nuwara Eliya

- After breakfast, proceed to Nuwara Eliya.
- En route **hike to Ramboda Falls.**
- Then continue your journey to Nuwara Eliya, Sri Lanka's "Little England" where time seems to have stood still since the days of the British occupation. On the way to Nuwara Eliya you will **visit waterfalls and a typical Tea Factory & enjoy a freshly brewed cup of tea.**
- On arrival check-in to the hotel and relax.
- Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 4



Nuwara Eliya – Horton's plains

- After an early breakfast (0600 hours) check out for a hike **to Horton's Plains national park**. Reach the Horton Plains which is located 2300m above the sea level. Thereafter enjoy the 09 Km trek (Approx. 05 Hours) witnessing the beautiful, silent highlands covered by cloud forest along with a **visit Bakers fall and World's End**.
- On completion return back to the hotel.
- Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 5



Nuwara Eliya – ELLA

- After an early breakfast check out and take a **train ride to Ella.**
- On arrival **hike to the Mini Adams peak in Ella.**
- Enjoy the scenic views and the cool climate on top of it.
- Then take a **trekking through the forest to 9 archs bridge.**
- Then take a **rail hike from 9 archs bridge to Ella railway station.**
- On completion return back to the hotel.
- Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 6



ELLA

- After an early breakfast start the **hike to Ella rock mountain**.
- Enjoy the breath taking sceneries from the top of the mountain.
- **Visit the Ravana falls in Ella.**
- Rest of the day leisure in the hotel.
- Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 7



Ella – Airport

- Morning after breakfast leisure in the hotel.
- Today you will be accompanied to the airport in time to board your flight back home.

Things to do throughout the tour

KANDY

The hill capital is another "World Heritage Site". It was the last stronghold of the Sinhalese Kings during the Portuguese, Dutch and British rule and finally ceded to the British in 1815 after an agreement. To the Buddhists of Sri Lanka and the World, Kandy is one of the most sacred sites as it is the home of the "Dalada Maligawa" – Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic of Lord Buddha. Close by are the remains of the Royal Palace ("Maha Wasala"), "Palle Wasala" – where the Queens stayed-now used for the National Museum, "Meda Wasala" where other close relatives lived, Audience Hall, Natha Devala and Vishnu Devala are situated close by. The Bathing Pavilion ("Ulpenge") is by the Lake and in the Center of the lake is the Island called "Kiri Samudraya" (Milk white ocean) used by the kings as the summerhouse.

NUWARA ELIYA

The "Little England" of Sri Lanka, is set against beautiful backdrops of Mountains, Valleys, Waterfalls and Tea Plantations. It is supposed to be one of the coolest places in the Island, but it is really just like an English spring day, although the temperature does drop at night. All around Nuwara Eliya you will see evidence of the British influence, houses like country cottages or Queen Ann style mansions. The Victoria Park, in the middle of the town, is lovely place for a stroll or a picnic and is also good for Birding as you get some rare birds in this park. Seasons may be absent elsewhere in Sri Lanka, but here you can read them by the flowers, which bloom in the spring (March to May) and fall (August and September). These are the "seasons" when low-country folk flock to Nuwara Eliya to escape the sea level heat and humidity.
