Overview

Stay in colonial style accommodation during the tour. Learn about the rich history of this Tropical Island. Find out more about the fascinating culture and be amazed by the beautiful scenery and golden beaches, thick forest, tea plantations and wildlife.

DAY 01: AIRPORT/COLOMBO

You will be met by your chauffeur-guide at the airport and transferred to a hotel in Colombo. Later in the evening you will commence a tour of Colombo.

Colombo, the commercial capital of Sri Lanka, has a long history as a port on ancient east-west trade routes, ruled successively by the Portuguese, Dutch and British. That heritage is reflected in its architecture, mixing colonial buildings with high-rises and shopping malls. The imposing Colombo National Museum, dedicated to Sri Lankan history, borders sprawling Viharamahadevi Park and its giant Buddha.

DAY 02: COLOMBO / NEGOMBO / ANURADAPURA

After breakfast leave for Anuradhapura en-route visit Negombo. Negombo is a major city in Sri Lanka, on the west coast of the island in close proximity to the international airport. It is also a fishing town once occupied by the Portuguese, Dutch and British Colonialists. You will find remnants of Colonial buildings in the vicinity in particular the Dutch Fort by the sea.

The Anuradhapura Kingdom was the first established kingdom in ancient Sri Lanka by King Pandukabhaya in 377 BC. Anuradhapura is also a sacred city for all Buddhists. You will see an ancient Bo tree, which was brought here in the 3rd century by Sangamitta, the founder of an ancient order of Buddhist nuns.

Overnight: The Grand Tissawewa

DAY 03: AUKANA/SIGIRIYA

After breakfast visit Aukana some 30km northwest of the Golden Dambulla Rock Temple.

What may be called one of the wonders of the world is the tall, standing statue of the Buddha at Aukana, another architectural marvel of the ancient Sinhalese. The rock cut statue which stands 39 feet above its decorated lotus plinth and 10 feet across the shoulders, belongs to the period of King Dhatusena (459-477 AD), the builder of the great reservoir Kalawewa. It has been very well

preserved over the years and is a joy for anyone to see and appreciate. It is a unique creation by an unknown sculptor.

Next, visit the ancient City of Sigiriya.

The ruins of the capital built by the parricidal King Kassapa I (477–95) lie on the steep slopes and at the summit of a granite peak standing some 180m high (the 'Lion's Rock', which dominates the jungle from all sides). A series of galleries and staircases emerging from the mouth of a gigantic lion constructed of bricks and plaster provides access to the site.

DAY 04: POLONNARUWA / MEDIRIGIRIYA

After breakfast visit the ancient city of Polonnaruwa. Polonnaruwa was first declared the capital city by King Vijayabahu I, who defeated Chola invaders in 1070 to reunite the country once more under a local leader. The Ancient City of Polonnaruwa has been declared a World Heritage Site. Currently the new Polonnaruwa is under going a major development project known as the "Awakening of Polonnaruwa" under the concept of President Maithripala Sirisena. It envisions the development of all sectors in Polonnaruwa including roads; electricity, agriculture, education, health and environment will be developed comprehensively.

In the late afternoon visit Medirigiriya Vatadage, which is on a high circular stage surrounded by stone pillars about three and a half feet in height. Medirigiriya Watadage is one of the oldest ruins in South Asia. The Medirigiriya Watadage (circular relic house) along with the two watadages at Polonnaruwa and Thiriyaya in the Trincomalee district are examples of the architecture that is unique to the ancient Sinhalese. The Polonnaruwa and Medirigiriya watadages are said to be identical in measurement and design but the setting of the latter adds to its mystic appeal.

DAY 05: DAMBULLA / MATALE / NALANDA GEDIGE / KANDY

After breakfast leave for Kandy en-route visit Dambulla, Nalanda Gedige and Kandy.

Kandy is a large city in central Sri Lanka. It's set on a plateau surrounded by mountains, which are home to tea plantations and bio diverse rainforest. The city's heart is scenic Kandy Lake (Bogambara Lake), which is popular for strolling. Kandy is famed for sacred Buddhist sites, including the Temple of the Tooth (Sri Dalada Maligawa) shrine, celebrated with the grand Esala Perahera annual procession.

Dambulla cave temple dates back to the 2nd century BC. It was known even before the making of the complex, as one of the largest monasteries in Sri Lanka and the caves became a major religious center during that period.

Dambulla is a UNESCO declared World Heritage Site. You can visit Nalanda Gedige the Abu Simbel of Sri Lanka. Nalanda Gedige is one of a number of remarkable archaeological sites in Sri Lanka. Thereafter you can visit a spice garden & a batik factory in Matale. (Optional)

DAY 06: KANDY / PINNAWELA / KANDY

After breakfast leave for Pinnawela & visit the elephant Orphanage. After breakfast leave for the Pinnawala elephant Orphanage. Pinnawala is one of Sri Lanka's popular attractions. The orphanage was established to feed, nurse & house young elephants abandoned in the wild. In the evening, do a city tour of Kandy and visit a Gem Museum. Late in the evening view the Kandyan cultural performance and return to your hotel for your overnight stay.

DAY 07: KANDY / PERADENIYA / NUWARAELIYA

After breakfast visit the royal botanical gardens of Peradeniya. The garden is best known for its collection of orchids and a large variety of plant species. Leave for Nuwara Eliya in the evening. Nuwara Eliya is situated in the central highlands of Sri Lanka. Visit a tea plantation and taste some the best teas in the world. Gregory Lake is one of attractions in the locality built by Governor William Gregory between 1872- 1877.

DAY 08: NUWARAELIYA/ELLA/BOUDURUWAGALA/KATARAGAMA/YALA

Get ready and leave for Tissamaharama. Take a brief stop at Ella to take in the amazing views and en route visit Buduruwagala the seven colossal figures carved out of a rock face at Buduruwagala, which is situated five kilometers south of Wellawaya.

The rock itself resembles a kneeling elephant with its head bowed and the end of its folded trunk in its mouth. In the evening take a wildlife safari in the Yala Park (by jeep).

Elephants are undoubtedly the best-known attraction at Yala, seen in small & large herds. Herds of spotted deer are seen all over the park too. Monkeys-the pinkish rhesus and the Grey-faced Langur monkey live and play on the treetops and the ground below.

Wild buffalo & wild boar would startle you with their presence & the sight of a leopard sunning itself or drinking water at a water hole could be a memorable experience.

(If Yala is closed during September-October period, the Bundala reserve can be visited).

DAY 09: WELIGAMA / GALLE / BEACH STAY

After Breakfast leave for Galle en-route stop at Weligama to watch the Fisherman on stilts. Visit the Galle Dutch Fort, museum & Church. Built in 1663, the fort still retains the atmosphere and charm of Dutch days. Many Old Dutch buildings are still intact inside the fort. The best way to see the fort is to walk around until it is time to watch the sunset. The Dutch Museum, which is housed in a restored Dutch mansion of the time, contains paintings, prints, documents, furniture and

ceramics from the Dutch colonial era. Dutch Reformed Church, built by a Dutch Army officer in 1754 is a must see building.

DAY 10: BEACH FREE DAY

It is your free day. Relax by the beach or do your own thing.
